C. Wireless Facilities Deployment Update

Over the past several months there has been a noticeable increase in requests by cellular carriers and/or their agents to approve local deployment of new wireless communication facilities. These include requests to deploy "small cell" equipment on existing structures or facilities (such as telephone poles) or construct new infrastructure that will serve as locations for carriers to deploy their equipment. NWMC reestablished a working group to address this issue and is working with other councils of government to prepare guidance to better facilitate the introduction of new infrastructure.
