### **III. Bike & Pedestrian Funding in the IIJA**

Staff presented information on new and increased funding for bicycle and pedestrian projects as part of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act. The presentation included information on specific programs and resources for communities to take advantage of new funding opportunities. Staff also

reviewed projects that directly improve or connect to NWMC Multimodal Priority Corridors through an online GIS Map.

Mr. Lysicatos asked if there were any qualifications on the local side that would be required such as data for HSIP funding. Ms. Johnson said that there are data requirements for HSIP funding and she would send that documentation in a follow up email.

**IV. Local Project Updates**

Ms. Schwab informed the committee that the Windsor Road diet is progressing through Phase 1. The village also extended the overall area of the Phase 1 study to Hintz Rd due to receiving additional STP funding.

Ms. Gabiga gave an update on the Meacham Road side path that has experienced issues with securing material; however, the improvement work is starting to wrap up. She said the project has received a lot of positive feedback from the public so far.
