I. Call to Order/Introductions

Mr. Buehler called the meeting to order at 10:33 a.m.

II. Approval of May 24, 2022 Meeting Minute

Ald. Sanoica moved approval of the May 24, 2022 meeting minutes. Mr. Mangum seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

III. Cook County Bike Plan Update

Mr. Haller, Transit Manager for the Cook County Department of Transportation provided an update on the progress of the Cook County Bike Plan. The plan focuses on three principles: ensuring that investments serve a greater number of county residents and are more equitable distributed; expanding the existing system of off-street trails and other low-stress routes into a coherent countywide network; and, enhancing facilities to support everyday biking.

IV. Meeting Topics for 2022

Staff offered possible upcoming meeting topics and requested feedback. In October and November CMAP will present on their Safety Resource Group and Title II Assistance Program. In January or February the group will learn more about Glenview' Bike-Ped plan & ADA Transition Plan. Mr. Simmons recommended looking into Bicycle Friendly Community program potentially being a meeting topic.

V. Local Project Updates

Mr. O'Brien provided an update for the Village of Niles. The North branch trail will be bid on November 23, and construction is expected to start later this year or early next year. He also announced that the Village along with Morton Grove and Skokie had a pre-construction meeting for the Oakton Multi-use path project.

Mr. Lysicatos provided an update for the Village of Schaumburg that the Village will be going into design for the martingale bike path later this fall.

VI. Other Business

Ms. Johnson reminded the committee that ITEP and Safe Streets 4 All applications will be closing soon.

Mr. Simmons reminded the committee that the Ride Illinois bike summit is coming up on October 12-13 in Champaign-Urbana.
